Math:

- Algebra I taken in an APS Middle School, will be placed on a student's transcript automatically unless a parent opts not to have it placed on the transcript by indicating that on the form they sign at the end of the 8th grade year. After it is placed on the HS transcript, it cannot be removed.
- Students must have 4 years of Math on their transcript with at least 1 year at the level of Algebra II or higher. The typical pattern is Alg. I, Geom., Alg. II, + a 4th year Math.
- Math Strategies only counts for elective credit, not Math credit.
- There are some approved Dual Credit Math courses that count for the 4th year Math credit.
