
JAN 5 - FAFSA filing priority date



RECENT GRADUATE LEARNERS

Full-time, NM residents* that graduate from a NM high school within the past 16 months.

100% TUITION & FEES

In 2022-23, covers full tuition, mandatory fees and course fees.

Scholarship reduced by 1st semester "bride" scholarships

SCHOLARSHIP DURATION

Awarded automatically beginning first semester, for up to 160 attempted hours. Must have 2.5 GPA & earned 15 new hours for continued eligibility.

*NM residency or eligible for non-discrimination or tribal boundaries waiver



100% TUITION COVERED

In 2022-2023, Lottery covers full tuition only

QUALIFYING CRITERIA

During first semester, 2.5 GPA each term and 15 new credit hours

SCHOLARSHIP DURATION

Awarded automatically, 7 consecutive semesters starting 2nd semester at UNM.

Scholarships available for the first-semester only.

Success Grant First-time freshmen only; 2.50 - 3.29 GPA & completed FAFSA, priority for students with financial need.	\$1,000	February 1
